

After Fair Action Report 2019

The most important item on the list would be personnel. With working 16 hour days and only three people and two trustee's it was very taxing. I would like to request 1 more full time year round employee to help with the maintenance of the grounds and to split the shift with Kyle so that the weekends are covered. With Stella bringing in more revenue last year I would think that this year with the track and new arena it will be even busier.

1st of May I would like to bring in two more full time seasonal employees, one for watering and mowing and one to help on the weekends to with the same. Both can help make repairs on buildings, tables, benches, paint and general maintenance.

One week before fair and we would need to bring on two more for shift work at the fair. This time would be utilized to train in the cleaning of the grounds during the fair. These last two would be just fair temps. Mainly walking around picking up garbage and where needed. One AM and one PM.

This would give us three people during the day with an overlap of time for dinner and three people at night and one on the tractor or water truck depending.

If we have trustees they would have a regular shift and help with garbage's and cleaning of the grounds.

- The north fence needs to be moved to the far end of the fair ground because people coming to the fair can take a left and come into the arena without going through the ticket booth. And a new gate for that fencing.
- A movable ramp to go over the track for vehicles to drive on so it does not get packed down we would need two one for the north and one for the south.
- More lighting is needed behind the Grange, 4-H and the Horticulture. To help with traffic flow during the fair. It would also help in the winter months for security. I would suggest LED with photo cell
- North out is also in need of better lighting
- The grand stands as you know are in dire need of replacing the footings as well as the supports.
- The septic system in the north restrooms is infested with roots. Not sure of all the options,
 - o 1 issue the willow tree's planted next to the tank.
 - o If the lid of the tank can be removed. Then we could reseal the tank.
 - o Replace the tank.
 - o Further research is needed.
- The commercial building floor is broken and needs leveling, roof need attention and gutter over door so water from the rain doesn't come in
- The floor in the horticulture building is asphalt and need some attention, it has divots in it from the dance floor being stored in it.
